



The Mission Fund was established to further the work of Saint Mother Teresa by administering to the poor and needy in God's name. As of September 30, 2022, 32 grants totaling \$2,809,742 have been distributed. Over the past 11 years, the Mission Fund has given over twenty two million dollars (22.0m) to over 200 grants to the Missionaries of Charity and other charitable projects around the world.
